Attaching your Rescue Swag

The Original Rescue Swag is designed to attach to any item you should require, ensuring that your first aid supplies are with you when you really need them

On the reverse of the kit you will find stainless steel clips, which provide durable, practical attachment points. Use the lockdown clips to fix your Rescue Swag in place, ensuring a snug fit to prevent movement.

You may also extend webbing straps to secure your kit, if clipping is not possible. Wrap the extended webbing around the object, clip and tighten. Ensure that webbing ends are securely tucked away and secured if fitting in this manner.



To use as a SPLINT:

- 1. Remove first aid packs from the Rescue Swag and zip it closed.
- 2. Lengthen the straps.
- 3. Wrap the Rescue Swag around the limb as shown, ensuring that the opening is to the outside of the limb. This allows straps to be easily adjusted. Overlap the ends of the Rescue Swag if possible.
- 4. Tighten the straps until the joint is immobilised or compression is achieved. Take care not to over tighten.



To use as a SLING:

- 1. Remove first aid packs from the Rescue Swag and zip it closed.
- 2. Lengthen the straps.
- 3. Make a roll with the Rescue Swag and secure with external velcro
- Carefully place the injured limb inside the roll.
- 5. Pass the extended strap around your neck and clip to the opposite
- 6. The second strap may be passed around the back and clipped in to the remaining buckle for greater stability.



To use as a WATER BAG:

- 1. Remove first aid packs from the Rescue Swag and zip up the sides
- 2. Line the Rescue Swag using the supplied plastic liner.
- 3. Fill with water as required.
